If you installed Clover in UEFI mode which I think you might have done then what you see is stored in the surfaces NVRAM as UEFI Bootentries. To get rid of them you need to delete this entries from NVRAM. Since I don't own a surface I am not sure how this might be done but I guess al6042 might be able to help you with that on Desktop Systems you can do it for instance with clover itself just choose "Clover Boot Options" on Clovers Bootscreen and select "Remove all Clover Boot Options" and you're done.
