You can set the resolution to 1024x768, then your problem is solved. Yes clover tries to set best resolution available, so obviously one of your screens doesn't support what the other does and it won't select that mode. My guess is your graphics card prefers the HDMI over DVI always, so EDID is taken from that during firmware post. Most likely your display has 1680x1050 as it's preferred display mode. It will choose best resolution unless you set another, you just happen to have two screens that aren't cool together since only one EDID is obtained. There is no way to independently drive the displays because EFI does not allow this. Also clover does nothing but use the driver protocol, nothing more than your firmware does. Just every display since like 1992 supports 1024x768...
