Probleme mit combo update und multibeast

my system runs almost perfectly.

the way...

0. set the cpu multiply to 32 or lower
1. install mac os x 10.6 using iboot 3.1.1
2. boot into mac os x 10.6 and do the combo update to 10.6.3
3. reboot using iboot 3.1.1 (because there is no chameleon installed)
4. do the combo update 10.6.6
5. run multibeast 3.7.2:

System Utilities, JMicron36x SATA, ElliottForceLegacyRTC, EvOreboot, FakeSMC, IOUSBFamily Rollback, NullCPUPowerManagement, Chameleon, 64-bit GraphicsEnabler=No, MacBook Pro, Chameleon RC5 Default, OSx86 Software

6. install BridgeHelper-2.1.0
7. reboot without bootdisk
8. be happy cause it works

(next steps are very important to use my graphiccard)

9. edit the string under SMproductname in /Extra/smbios.plist to MacBookPro8,1 (could be that it is already the string)
10. reboot
11. edit /System/Library/CoreServices/SystemVersion.plist

copy the file to your desktop and open it from desktop
(because you need the writepermissions)

change the string under ProductBuildVersion to 10J3210
and save file and move it back to /System/Library/CoreServices/

12. download Mac OS X v10.6.7 Update for early 2011 MacBook Pro

13. install this combo update and reboot.
