Update: I successfully partitioned my NVMe SSD, and created a OS X Sierra USB installation via Unibeast. The installation actually starts up and brings me to the OS X installer screen. The problem, as noted above, appears to be that OS X does not recognize the NVMe drive. This is something I am working on at the moment. In addition, the PS2 Voodoo kext for keyboard causes me to have a Kernel Panic when running the installer. The touchpad kext does not do anything for me.

SO, now I am working on trying to compile a unique Kext for my NVMe drive. This is fun. If it works I will update you on it.
