First and foremost:
I use this card with my macbook pro (Late 2008) running El Capitan 10.11.2. *** IT IS NOT DESIGNED/ADVERTISED TO DO SO ***
However, with some careful steps and some research you too can do so. I have not tried it in any of my windows machines as they do not have Expresscard slots. This card uses the Renesas uPD720200 chipset (at least mine does).

This card has been noted to work on several forums with multiple versions of OSX, but the basics are as follows (in El Capitan):

1. Disable System Integrity Protection (SIP), this cannot be re-enabled if you want the card to work.
2. Grab Kext Utility (not necessary, but it is nice, and helps with permissions)
3. Grab a modified version of AppleUSBXHCI.kext (I used 10.10.5 for reference). This is why SIP needs to be disabled.
4. Backup the existing copy of the AppleUSBXHCI.kext, you can do this manually or let the utility do it for you.
5. Install Kext using the utility or manually (whatever your pleasure)
6. reboot your mac, and install the card, you should be good to go.

Also as a note, if you do get things running, you will not be able to get full USB 3.0 speed on the Late 2008 Macbook Pro. HOWEVER, you will get noticeable improvement over 2.0 (as long as you are running a 3.0 device... obviously), generally I was able to cut my file copy speeds by 33%, which for me is pretty significant.
