**9.4 Recommended Variables**  
The following variables are recommended for faster startup or other improvements:

- `7C436110-AB2A-4BBB-A880-FE41995C9F82:prev-lang:kbd`  
Hardware BootProduct (e.g. `Mac-INT1995C9F82:prev-lang:kbd`). Not present on real Macs, but used to avoid extra parsing of `SMEMEM` tables, especially in boot.efi.
- `4C1E8808-98C7-468A-9028-48C2A8B8C14:hw_mbl`  
Hardware BootProduct/Platform. Overrides for MLE. Present on newer Macs (2012+ at least).
- `4C1E8808-98C7-468A-9028-48C2A8B8C14:hw_mbl`  
Hardware BEHE. Overrides for BEHE. Present on newer Macs (2012+ at least).
- `7C436110-AB2A-4BBB-A880-FE41995C9F82:prev-lang:kbd`  
ARCT string defining default keyboard layout. Format is lang-COUNTRY (keyboard, e.g. `ru-RU-282` for Russian locale and ABC keyboard). Also accepts short forms: `ru-282` or `ru-RU-282` (U.S. keyboard, compatible with 30.0). Full detailed keyboard list from `AppleKeyboardLayouts-L.dat` can be found [here](#). Using non-latin keyboard on 32.14 will not enable ABC keyboard. [Apple provides user management controls](#), and is then not recommended in case you need 32.14.

- `7C436110-AB2A-4BBB-A880-FE41995C9F82:securetp:mode`  
ARCT string defining FileVault security mode. Legacy, can be found in `IOFileVaultFamily` source code in `IOFileVaultController.cpp`. It is recommended not to set this variable, which may speedup system startup. Setting to `Full` is equivalent to not setting the variable and thus disables FileVault security.
- `4C1E8808-98C7-468A-9028-48C2A8B8C14:UIScale`  
One-byte data defining boot.efi's user interface scaling. Should be `01` for normal screens and `02` for HEDP screens.
- `4C1E8808-98C7-468A-9028-48C2A8B8C14:DefaultBackgroundColor`  
Four-byte RGBA data defining boot.efi's user interface background color. Standard colors include `BF BF BF 00` (Light Gray) and `00 00 00 00` (Dark Black). Other colors may be set at user's preference.
