HideAuxiliary hat mit EFI-Partitionen nichts zu tun. Es ist in der OpenCore-Dokumentation doch genau erklärt, was es betrifft:

• NVRAM — USE NVRAM OPTION.  
3. HideAuxiliary  
Type: plist boolean  
Failafe: false  
Description: Hides auxiliary entries from picker menu by default.  
An entry is considered auxiliary when at least one of the following applies:  
• Entry is macOS recovery.  
• Entry is macOS Time Machine.  
• Entry is explicitly marked as Auxiliary.  
• Entry is system (e.g. Reset NVRAM).  
To see all entries picker menu needs to be reloaded in extended mode by pressing Spacebar key. Hiding auxiliary  
entries may increase boot performance for multiboot systems.
