Why do you have 2 ACPI files for different models in there? VoodooHDA is crap. ACPIBattery can also be omitted by using the SMCBattery Kext. Personally, I would prefer to take everything from a single source (OpenCore developer) you also have 2 USB Kexts in it where I don't understand why. USBInjectAll or USBPorts.kext.

Don't get me wrong, but your EFI is not so "clean" thought out.

Yea I know that it is not so "clean" but the only reason I keep it with two ACPI files is because I want to make minimal changes to the config.plist when switching between the eb g1 and eb g2. and I know that VoodooHDA is crappy but I cant seem to get the microphone to work properly at all. It dies out in 2 hours and has a clicking sound. and dosent work if the system goes to sleep and wakes up. ik about the ACPIBattery but im just to lazy lol. I never got USBs to work without both USBInjectAll and USBPorts.kext on OC 0.5.9-0.6.3 so i never bothered taking it out for the OC 0.6.4 update. issues smh. Ill just do it now ig.
