

i9 10900k / Gigabyte Z490 Vision D - Er läuft

It's been a while since I made that Vision D-Build (for a friend who also uses it for music production with logic). Just some comments, but overall your components are looking good!

Board: good choice in my eyes, everything is working perfectly with Schmocklords config.

Thunderbolt should work without problems, my friend also uses it for a UAD Apollo interface.

CPU: both should work and deliver good performance for daw-use. I only ever used the 10900k, but a lot of people here say that the difference to 10850k is very small. I cooled mine with "be quiet dark rock pro 4" air cooler. it gets near the temperature limit under full avx-load, but its enough to keep the system working without thermal throtteling. water cooling would get you better temperatures, but I don't know anything about AiO or custom water cooling.

SSDs: I use a smaller xpg gammix SSD in my older hackintosh without problems, I guess the 2TB Model will also work without problems. In general, SSDs are not known to make a lot of trouble. just check dortania's anti-hackintosh-buyers-guide, section "storage" to be sure.

GPU: should work out of the box with macos.

Wifi/BT: fenvi t919 is well known, but others with BCM94360CD chipsets can work too. this chipset works out of the box, no kexts or other tweaks are needed.
