Do you know of a way to connect the internal speaker without sacrificing the regular rear IO speakers or front headphone jack?

Yes, I found a way. You are right, OpenCore can not output at the boot picker stage to USB. This is the reason, why I use the front headphone jack for connecting the internal speaker. So the boot chime will sound out of the speaker. For headphone jack on Power Mac G5 chassis I use the front microphone jack connector on mainboard. I have modified a layout id by myself for AppleALC, which converts the front microphone jack input into a headphone output (as you see on my screenshot from my earlier post). did you use a 12v line coming from a fan header to power the amplifier or something else?

No, the amplifier is power via 5V from internal USB connector.
