Subject adobe apps (on AMD):

Many things are changed in the last time

Now you do not have to delete stuff or using old libraries to have all th adobe suite working **perfectly**.

It is possible to patch all the app with a click using AMDFriend script (you can search also in this forum for additional informations about it)

Subject AMD vs Intel:

Your budget is lower than about 1000 €, otherwise I would suggest to build a Hackintosh like the one you see in my signature.

It works perfectly with Thunderbolt (titan ridge 1.0 in my rig) and also with firewire 800 (you have to find one with an OSX supported chip)

For thunderbolt you may have the need to patch its firmware and a SSDT to enable hot swap feature

In my rig I have on it a NVME disk with windows 11 OS and I can boot from it also from Opencore bootmenu

About Thunderbolt, it is more simple to have all the functionality working if you choose a motherboard who supports thunderbolt to have some bios option to set

Otherwise you would need to boot in OSX first to have thunderbolt disk see in your bios (in my rig if I start from a cold boot I can't see in bios my thunderbolt hd)

some things to keep in mind are that with AMD you have to deal with kernel patches and hope the opencore developers don't block us!

But even if they don't directly support AMD CPUs they are good guys and have always produced some useful improvements even for us! 😊

configuration you are evaluating seems to me very good!
