Important message!

If you are currently using MacForge and have turned off Apple Mobile File Integrity (AMFI) using the command `nvram boot-args="amfi_get_out_of_my_way=0" ( on 0x1 )`

You will not be able to add applications to System Preferences > Security & Privacy > Privacy. This can completely prevent some applications from functioning or break critical functionality.

In order to fix this issue, follow the steps below:

1. open terminal and run the next command
2. `sudo nvram boot-args="" ; sudo defaults write /Library/Preferences/com.apple.security.libraryvalidation.plist DisableLibraryValidation -bool true`
3. reboot

An updated version of MacForge should hopefully be coming out soon™ with a built in warning and automation of these steps.
