you have to relaunch again macOS installer icon, if you have, for a couple of time, then you should see normal OSX icon to go on in latest installation steps

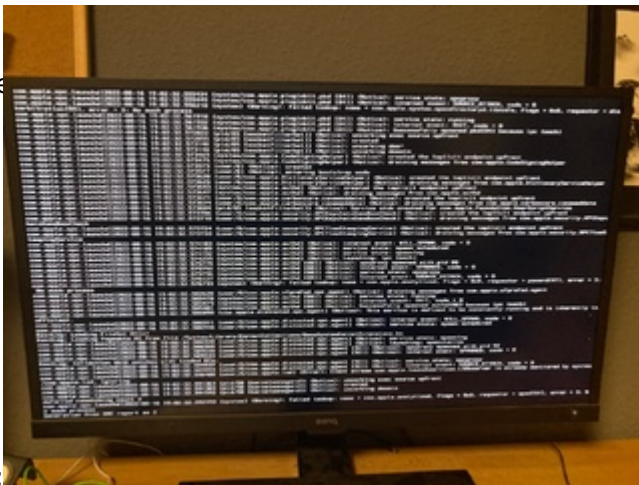
